Job Requirements: *High School Students must be 16

- 1. Must be 18* years of age or older
- 2. Registered Voter in Eastland County
- 3. Do not hold an elected office or are not the employee of an elected official
- 4. Are not a family member of an elected official on the ballot
- 5. Are detail-oriented; able to take direction well and not easily distracted
- 6. Excellent interpersonal skills in order to interact, cooperate, and deal effectively with coworkers, voters, poll watchers, electioneers, and the public.
- 7. Must have dependable transportation to and from the Election Polling place
- 8. Able to lift at least 30 lbs. and stand or sit for long periods of time
- 9. Ability to work long shifts, weekends, and rotating schedules
- 10. Ability to stand and sit for extended periods of time'
- 11. Basic computer skills and or familiarity with technology
- 12. Ability to read, comprehend and follow Texas Election Laws and instructions given by the Eastland County Elections Administrator.

- 14. Ability to recognize election issues and promptly report any issue to the appropriate person
