ORDER GRANTING RELATOR’S REQUEST FOR MANDAMUS

On the 10th day of December, 2024, came on for hearing Relator’s motion for a Rule 12 hearing. Relator’s attorney, Jim Farrar, appeared in person and the Respondents’ attorney Bradley Bullock, appeared in person, and both announced to the Court that agreement had been reached by the parties and their attorneys as to the remaining issues in dispute; that each party would submit briefs and their arguments for the consideration of the Court no later than December 16, 2024, and the Court would decide the remaining matters on the pleadings, the evidence in the file as of December 10th, and the submissions, and no further testimony or evidence would be made to, or received by the Court after the 16th.

The Court having carefully considered the pleadings, evidence and arguments submitted to it by the attorneys for the Relator and the Respondents, the Court hereby grants the petition for mandamus as to the Ranger city commissioners (respondents Terry Robinson, Joe Sigler, Wendy Erwin and Intervenor Jared Calvert) are directed to schedule a special election for the recall of commissioners Robinson, Sigler and Erwin not less than fifteen days and not more than thirty days from the date of this judgment.

This judgment finally disposes all claims and all parties and is non-appealable.
