

RESOLUTION 2026-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EASTLAND, TEXAS, ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 2, 2026, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO CITY COMMISSIONERS BY THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF EASTLAND; AUTHORIZING A JOINT ELECTION WITH EASTLAND INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT (EISD), EASTLAND MEMORIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT (EMHD), AND EASTLAND COUNTY WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT (ECWSD),

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EASTLAND:

Section 1. That a general election is hereby ordered to be held on the 2nd day of May 2026, for the purpose of electing Two (2) City Commissioners by the qualified voters of the City of Eastland.

Section 2. That the City of Eastland agrees to hold a joint election with the EISD, EMHD, ECWSD.

Section 3. That the Election Day polls for said election shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the designated polling place and the County Joint Elections Administrator is hereby directed to conduct the election.


Section 4. Early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall commence on Monday, April 20, 2026, and continue through Tuesday, April 28, 2026. The Eastland County Courthouse will be open for voting during the early voting period from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday, except as outlined in Section 5, the place for early voting for such election is hereby designated as follows:

EARLY VOTING LOCATION: Eastland County Courthouse

Eastland, Texas 76448

Section 5. As required under Section 85.005 (d), of the Texas Election Code, early voting by personal appearance at the early voting polling place shall be conducted for at least 12 hours on two weekdays, if the early voting period consists of six or more weekdays; therefore, the first and second Tuesday of the early voting period have been designated as the two 12 hours days. The early voting polling place will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on those days.

Section 6. The Board of City Commissioners is authorized to sign an Order of Election and the Chairman to sign the Notice of Election prescribed by the State of Texas. The Notice of Election shall be published in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and the City Charter.
